Tips-What to do if you lose your job:

- ◇ If you are eligible for benefits, apply immediately. This includes unemployment benefits, SNAP food assistance, Energy Assistance Program or government health insurance. Call 2-1-1 for more information.
- ◇ Take a look at your household budget and cut back wherever possible.
- ◇ Stop using any credit cards you have. Ask if they will accept less than minimum payments.
- ◇ Call Utility companies to see if there are any payment arrangement available before you fall behind.
- ◇ Call 2-1-1 for resources that may be available to help you with your expenses.
- ◇ Don't forget to take in account the cost of basic needs. Set priorities when laying out the framework for
